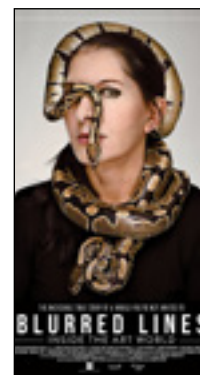


This documentary looks at America's first school of landscape painting, when a group of American painters forged an artistic vision of the American wilderness.
