Resources for Job Seekers

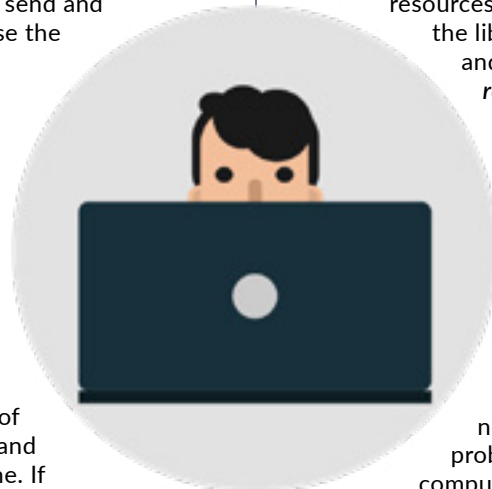
Tuesday, Feb. 20 at 10:30 p.m.
