Late 50's Kendall Park Estates homes available for \$400. down.

GI mortgage rate of 4 3/4 %. The Edgebrook model had 9 rooms,
2 full baths on 1/3 acre of land and sold for \$16,000.

1958 The Co-operative Nursery School Association was started by K. P. parents and operated from Six Mile Run Church, Franklin Park.

1958 The South Brunswick League of Women Voters was organized by a group from Kendall Park.

1958 through 1964
Irv and Mary Ann Stein produce the Kendall Park News

newsletter to keep Kendall Parkers informed of local items.

1958 Cambridge School, the first of Kendall Park Schools, opens.

1959 Sand Hills Road paved from Beekman intersection to Hawthorne Rd.

1959 Kendall Park Shopping Center opens.

1959 32-lane Bowling Alley opens adjacent to shopping center.

1959 Constable School opens.

1967 Kendall Park Volunteer Fire Company incorporated.
