## **SBPL Skilled Volunteer Squad** **(Counts as Leadership)**

- All applicants must be in grades 9-12.
- Each applicant is required to also have current Teen Volunteer Application on file.
- Applicants must be skilled in one of the following areas: Technology, Visual or Performing Arts
- Applicants must be prepared to provide proof of skill by providing a sample of their work in whatever they wish to teach (For Example: bit of code with an explanation of what it does, piece of artwork, video you made, video of a performance you're in, etc)
- Applicants must have a letter of recommendation from someone knowledgeable in that skill (ideally someone who has seen your work or worked with you).
- If you are missing any documentation, your application is not complete and you are ineligible to join with an incomplete application.
- If you are applying as part of a group, please indicate the names & grades of those participating with you at the end of the application. All members of the group must be approved and members of the Skilled Volunteer Squad in order to receive equal credit and be eligible to also run events.
